Our Current Web Platform

* Our current CMS (Hannon Hill's Cascade CMS) and Portal (Uportal) did not currently offer a simple way to integrate a social networking platform.

Using Web 2.0 Tools:

* We are currently using a number of Web 2.0 tools including: B2Evolution, Facebook, Flickr, LiveStream, and YouTube.

Social Networking Platforms:

* We looked at a number of social networking platforms including: E-Crowds, Facebook, Ning, and SocialEngine.





Rollout Strategy

- * Phase One:
 - * Begin with a small test group of about 12 people.
- * Phase Two:
 - * Once they test it, then ask them to invite 3 friends.
 - * This will build upon the idea of "trusted relationships".
 - * Observe what they do and see where the site can be improved. Get feedback from them in terms of design.
- * Phase three: Go live!
